All merit badges classes are held at the Visitor Center at Fort Harrison State Park starting at 1 p.m. The cost is \$10 per Scout per merit badge, payable at the park entrance. Advance registration is required. Register by emailing DAllison@dnr.IN.gov. Our program is \$10/Scout but that includes park entry. Although we do not charge an extra \$7 for entry, we do NOT subtract \$7 for those who have an annual pass.

Please note that Scouts cannot be dropped off and left unattended with park staff—parents/guardians must remain with their Scouts at all times throughout the duration of the program. Park staff will not be responsible for children left unattended.
